21.07.2026: In the instant company appeal, the grievance agitated by the appellant is as against the rejection of his application preferred under Section 7 of IBC.

2. The company appeal is supported with I.A. No. 1403 of 2023 on which the notices were issued to the respondents and despite the substituted service, being carried by the appellant in pursuance to the order dated 11.09.2023, none has appeared even till today. Hence, the matter was directed to proceed ex-parte against the respondent.

3. When this company appeal has been taken up today the appellant presses upon the I.A. No. 1403 of 2023 where the appellant has sought a condonation of two days of delay that has chanced in preferring the company appeal.
