ORDINARY BUSINESS:

1. To consider and adopt the audited financial statement of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2026 and the reports of the Board of Directors and Auditors thereon and in this regard, to consider and if deemed fit, to pass the following resolutions as an **Ordinary Resolution**:

“RESOLVED THAT the audited financial statement of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2026 and the reports of the Board of Directors and Auditors thereon, as circulated to the members, be and are hereby considered and adopted.”

1. No Special Business proposed to be conducted / transacted at the ensuing Annual General Meeting, therefore Statement pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Companies Act, 2013 is not annexed herewith.
2. **A Member entitled to attend and vote at the Meeting is entitled to appoint a Proxy to attend and, on a poll, to vote instead of himself and the Proxy need not be a Member of the company.**
3. **Pursuant to provisions of Section 105 of the Companies Act 2013, a person can act as a proxy on behalf of Members not exceeding 50 and holding in the aggregate not more than ten percent of the total share capital of the company carrying voting rights. A Member holding more than ten percent of total share capital of the company carrying voting rights may appoint a single person as proxy and such person shall not act as a proxy for any other person or shareholder. Proxies, in order to be effective, must be received in the enclosed Proxy Form at the Registered Office of the company not less than forty-eight hours before the time fixed for the Meeting. Proxy holder shall prove his/her identity at the time of attending the Meeting.**
4. During the period beginning 24 hours before the time fixed for the commencement of Meeting and ending with the conclusion of the Meeting, a Member would be entitled to inspect the proxies lodged at any time during the business hours of the company i.e. from 09:00 A.M. to 06:00 P.M.
5. Institutional / Corporate Member intending to send its authorised representatives to attend the Meeting in terms of Section 113 of the Companies Act, 2013 is requested to send to the company a certified copy of the Board Resolution / power of attorney authorizing such representative to attend and vote on its behalf at the Meeting.
6. Members / Proxies / Authorised Representatives are requested to bring their Attendance slip/proxy form duly filled in, sent herewith alongwith the Notice of the AGM at the Meeting. The members who hold shares in dematerialized form are requested to bring their Client Master List / Depository Participant Statement/ Delivery Instruction Slip reflecting their Client ID and DP ID No. for easier identification of attendance at the meeting.
7. In case of joint holders attending the Meeting, only such joint holder who is first in order of names will be entitled to vote.
8. In terms of Section 152 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Articles of Association of the Company, Mr. Pushpendra Jain (DIN: 03228950), Director and Chief Financial Officer, retires by rotation at the forthcoming AGM and being eligible, offers himself for reappointment. The Board of Directors recommends the aforesaid appointment / reappointment. As per explanation to Section 152(6)(e) of the Companies Act, 2013, total number of Directors for the purpose of determining Directors liable to retire by rotation shall not include Independent Directors.
9. Additional information, pursuant to Secretarial Standard-2 and regulation 36 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, in respect of the Director seeking re-appointment at the AGM is annexed hereto and forms integral part of the notice. The Director has furnished consent/declaration for his re-appointment as required under the Companies Act, 2013 and the rules made thereunder.
10. Register of Directors and Key Managerial Personnel and their shareholding maintained under Section 170 of the Companies Act, 2013 and Register of Contracts or arrangement in which Directors are interested as stipulated under Section 189 of the Companies Act, 2013 and are open for inspection by members and others



at the registered office of the company on all working days during business hours of the company i.e. from 09:00 A.M. to 06:00 P.M. The said Registers shall also be produced at the commencement of Annual General Meeting and shall remain open and accessible during the continuance of the meeting to a person having the right to attend the meeting.

11. The Register of Beneficial Owner, Register of Members and Share Transfer books of the Company shall remain closed from Wednesday, 23rd September, 2026 to Tuesday, 29th September, 2026 (both days Inclusive) for the purpose of the 41st AGM.
12. **Consolidation of Share Certificates:** Members holding shares in physical form, in identical order of names, in more than one folio are requested to send to the Company's RTA, the details of such folios together with the share certificates along with the requisite KYC documents for consolidating their holdings in one folio. Requests for consolidation of share certificates shall be processed in dematerialized form.
13. **Dematerialisation of shares:** Regulation 40 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) 2015, as amended mandates that transfer, transmission and transposition of securities of listed companies held in physical form shall be effected only in demat mode. Members holding shares in physical form are requested to consider converting their holding to dematerialized form to eliminate all risks associated with physical shares and for ease of portfolio management. Members can contact the Company or the Registrar and Share Transfer Agent for assistance in this regard.
14. SEBI vide its notification dated January 24, 2022 has mandated that all requests for transfer of securities including transmission and transposition requests shall be processed only in dematerialized form. In view of the same and to eliminate all risks associated with physical shares and avail various benefits of dematerialization, Members are advised to dematerialize the shares held by them in physical form. Members can contact the Company or RTA, for assistance in this regard.
15. Further Members may please note that SEBI vide its Circular No. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSD_RTAMB/P/CIR/2022/8 dated January 25, 2022 has mandated the Listed Companies to issue securities in demat form only while processing service requests viz. issue of duplicate securities certificate; claim from Unclaimed Suspense Account; Renewal/Exchange of securities certificate; Endorsement; Sub-division/Splitting of securities certificate; Consolidation of securities certificates/folios; Transmission and Transposition. Accordingly, Members are requested to make service requests by submitting a duly filled and signed **Form ISR-4**, the format of which is available on the Company's website and can be accessed through the link: <http://www.asiapackltd.com/Index/InvestorsServiceProcedure> and on the website of the Company's RTA and can be accessed through the link: https://www.bigshareonline.com/resources-sebi_circular.aspx. It may be noted that any service request can be processed only after the folio is KYC compliant.
16. SEBI vide its circulars issued from time to time has mandated that all shareholders holding shares in physical form to furnish PAN, Choice of Nomination (Optional), Contact Details (Postal Address with PIN and Mobile Number), Bank A/c details and specimen signature for their corresponding folio numbers. Shareholder(s) whose folio(s) do not have PAN, Contact Details, Bank Account Details and Specimen Signature updated, shall be eligible to lodge grievance or avail any service request from the RTA only after furnishing PAN, KYC details. With effect from April 1, 2024, for any payment including dividend, interest or redemption payment in respect of such folios, only through electronic mode.

The forms for updation of PAN, KYC, Bank details and Nomination viz. Forms **ISR-1**, **ISR-2**, **ISR-3** and **SH-13** are available on our website at <http://www.asiapackltd.com/Index/InvestorsServiceProcedure>. In view of the above, we urge Members holding shares in physical form to submit the required forms duly filled up and signed,



along with the supporting documents at the earliest to the RTA. Members who hold shares in dematerialised form and wish to update their PAN, KYC, Bank details and Nomination, are requested to contact their respective DPs.

Further, the holders of physical securities are requested to ensure that their PAN is linked to Aadhaar as per the date specified by the Central Board of Direct Taxes.

17. Members are requested to register / intimate changes, if any, pertaining to their name, postal address with PIN, email address, telephone/mobile numbers, Permanent Account Number (PAN), nominations, power of attorney, bank details such as, name of the bank and branch details, bank account number, MICR code, IFSC code, etc., the members are required to intimate the same:

- a. For shares held in electronic form: to their respective Depository Participants; and
- b. For shares held in physical form: to the Company / Registrar and Transfer Agent of the Company in prescribed **Form ISR-1**. Further the Company has already sent letters to the members holding shares in physical form to furnish the abovementioned details which are not registered in their respective folio no.(s).

18. **Nomination facility:** In accordance with the provisions of Section 72 of the Act and SEBI circulars, the facility for nomination is available for the members of the Company in respect of the shares held by them. Members who have not yet registered their nomination are requested to register the same by submitting the Form No. SH-13. If a Member desires to opt out or cancel the earlier nomination and record a fresh nomination, he/she may submit the same in Form No. ISR-3 or Form No. SH-14, as the case may be. Further, all new Members are mandatorily required to provide the choice of nomination for their demat accounts (except for jointly held demat accounts).

Members are requested to submit the said details to their respective DP, in case the shares are held by them in dematerialized form and to RTA, in case the shares are held by them in physical form.

19. To prevent fraudulent transactions, Members are advised to exercise due diligence and notify the Company of any change in address or demise of any Member as soon as possible. Members are also advised to not leave their Demat account(s) dormant for long. Periodic statement of holdings should be obtained from the concerned DP and holdings should be verified from time to time.
 20. **Special Window for Transfer and Dematerialisation of Physical Securities:** SEBI vide its Circular No. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2025/97 dated July 02, 2025, opened a Special Window for a period of six months from July 07, 2025 till January 06, 2026 for re-lodgement of transfer deeds of physical securities to facilitate ease of investing for investors and to secure their rights in the securities purchased by them. Further, in order to facilitate investors in obtaining rightful access to their securities, SEBI, vide Circular No. HO/38/13/11(2)2026-MIRSD-POD/I/3750/2026 dated January 30, 2026, has opened a special window for transfer and dematerialisation ("demat") of physical securities that were sold/purchased prior to April 01, 2019. The special window shall remain open for a period of one year from February 05, 2026 to February 04, 2027, and shall also be available for transfer requests that were earlier submitted but were rejected, returned or remained unattended due to deficiencies in documentation, process or otherwise. Securities transferred under
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the said special window shall be credited to the transferee only in dematerialised form and shall remain under lock-in for a period of one year from the date of registration of transfer. During the lock-in period, such securities shall not be transferred, pledged or lien-marked.

Eligible investors may avail this facility by submitting the requisite documents and completing the prescribed procedural formalities as specified under the said SEBI Circular. The detailed eligibility criteria, procedure and copy of the SEBI Circular are available on the website of SEBI at <https://www.sebi.gov.in/> and on the Company's website at <http://www.asiapackltd.com/Index/InvestorsView/47>

21. **Simplification of Procedure for Issuance of Duplicate Share Certificates:** SEBI vide its circular no. HO/38/13/11(3)2025-MIRSD-POD/I/1102/2025 dated 24th December, 2025 has simplified the process for issuance of duplicate share certificates. The value threshold for documentation has been increased from Rs. 5 lakh to Rs. 10 lakh and the documentation requirements have been standardised as under:

Upto Rs. 10,000	Undertaking on plain paper (no notarisation required)
Above Rs. 10,000 and up to Rs. 10,00,000	Single Affidavit-cum-Indemnity Bond
Above Rs. 10,00,000	Affidavit-cum-Indemnity Bond along with FIR / Police Complaint and Newspaper Advertisement

22. **Dispute Resolution:** SEBI vide Circular Nos. SEBI/HO/OIAE/OIAE_IAD-1/P/ CIR/2023/131 dated July 31, 2023, and SEBI/HO/OIAE/ OIAE_IAD-1/P/CIR/2023/135 dated August 4, 2023, read with Master Circular No. SEBI/HO/OIAE/OIAE_IAD-1/P/ CIR/2023/145 dated July 31, 2023 (updated as on August 11, 2023 and December 20, 2023) and consolidated under the Master Circular No. SEBI/HO/OIAE/OIAE_IAD-1/P/CIR/2023/183 dated December 28, 2023, has established a common Online Dispute Resolution Portal (ODR Portal) for resolution of disputes arising in the Indian Securities Market. Pursuant to the said framework, investors who have exhausted the option to resolve their grievances with the RTA/Company directly and through existing SCORES platform, may initiate dispute resolution through the ODR Portal: <https://smartodr.in/login>, the Copy of Circulars and ODR Portal can also be accessed through the Company's website at <http://www.asiapackltd.com/Index/smartodr>.

23. **Electronic Dissemination of the AGM Notice and Annual Report:** Notice of the AGM, along with the Annual Report for the year 2025-26, is being sent only through electronic mode to those members whose email addresses are registered with the Company / Registrar and Transfer Agent ("RTA") / Depository Participants ("DPs") / Depositories.

In terms of Regulation 36(1)(b) of the Listing Regulations the Letter providing the web-link, including the exact path, where complete details of the Annual Report is available, is being sent to those shareholder(s) who have not registered their email address with the Company / RTA / DPs / Depositories.

29. REMOTE E-VOTING / VOTING THROUGH ELECTRONIC MEANS / INSTRUCTIONS OF E-VOTING:

In compliance with Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rules 20 and 21 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended by the Companies (Management and Administration) Amendment Rules, 2015, and Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, the Company is pleased to provide its members with the facility to exercise their voting rights electronically on the resolutions proposed to be considered at the Meeting. The business of the Meeting may be transacted through the electronic voting (e-Voting) facility. For this purpose, the Company has engaged National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) to provide the remote e-Voting facility, enabling members to cast their votes electronically from a location other than the venue of the AGM.

The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members/list of Beneficial Owners as on Tuesday, 22nd September, 2026 being the cut-off date, are entitled to vote on the Resolutions set forth in this Notice. The voting right of Members shall be in proportion to their share in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date. A person who is not a Member as on the cut-off date should treat this Notice of AGM for information purpose only
 - C. The remote e-voting period begins on Friday, 25th September, 2026 (09:00 A.M.) and ends on Monday, 28th September, 2026 (05:00 P.M.). The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members / Beneficial Owners as on the record date (cut-off date) i.e. Tuesday, 22nd September, 2026, may cast their vote electronically. The voting right of shareholders shall be in proportion to their share in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date, being on Tuesday, 22nd September, 2026.

How to Log-in to NSDL e-Voting website?

1. Visit the e-Voting website of NSDL. Open web browser by typing the following URL: <https://www.evoting.nsdl.com/> either on a Personal Computer or on a mobile.
2. Once the home page of e-Voting system is launched, click on the icon "Login" which is available under 'Shareholder/Member' section.
3. A new screen will open. You will have to enter your User ID, your Password/OTP and a Verification Code as shown on the screen.

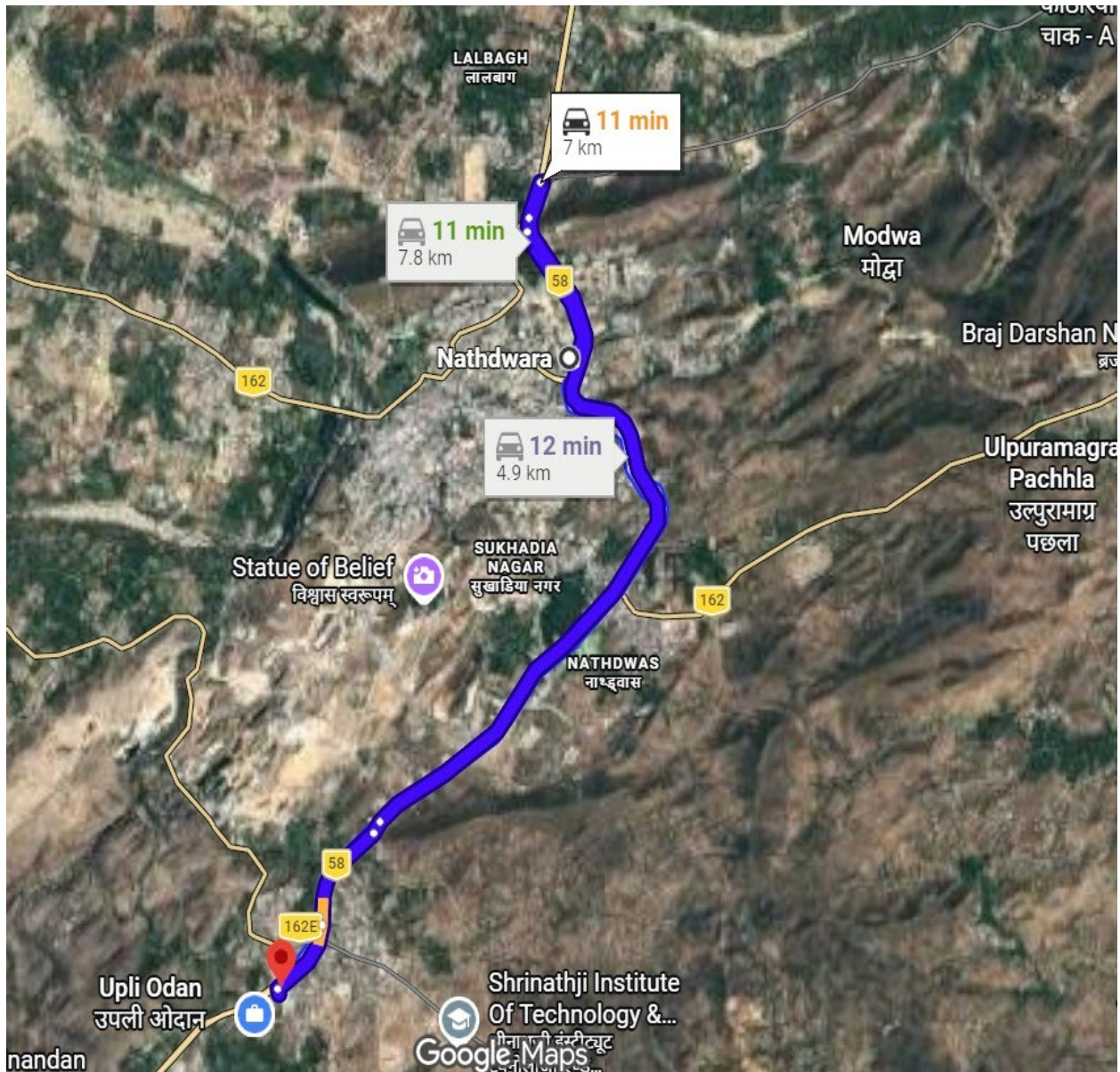
