UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. The present proceedings by way of Miscellaneous Application are in the nature of appeal against the order dated 25.04.2026 passed by the Registrar lodging the Miscellaneous Application (C) D. No. 9725 of 2026 seeking modification of order dated 06.01.2026 passed in SLP (C) No. 383 of 2026 which came to be dismissed.
3. By order dated 25.04.2026, the Registrar refused to receive and register the Miscellaneous Application and proceeded to

lodge it under Order XV Rule 5 of the Supreme Court Rules.

4. Having heard learned senior counsel for the applicant and having considered the matter in detail, we allow the Miscellaneous Application D.No. 32082 of 2026 being an appeal against the Registrar's order dated 25.04.2026 and restore the Miscellaneous Application D. No. 9725 of 2026 to its original number.

5. We clarify that Suit No. 20 of 2023 will be decided on its own merit, subject to such objections as may be raised independent of our order dated 06.01.2026.

6. With this clarification, the Miscellaneous Application D.No. 9725 of 2026 stands disposed of.
