O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Having regard to the submissions made by Mr. Balbir Singh, learned senior counsel on behalf of the petitioner(s) and without expressing any opinion on the

merits of the petitioners' claim at this stage, we propose to issue notice for the purpose of exploring a mediated settlement between the parties.

3. Issue notice to respondent(s) to appear before the Mediator to be nominated by the Coordinator of the Supreme Court Mediation Centre on 1st July, 2026 at 12:00 noon.

4. The parties shall be at liberty to join the proceedings before the Mediator through the virtual mode on the first few occasions. However, thereafter, if the Mediator requires their personal appearance, we hope and trust that the parties shall act accordingly.

5. Re-list the special leave petition in the week commencing 24th August, 2026.

6. If, in the meantime, the report of the Mediator is received, the same shall be placed on record.

7. We clarify that this order issuing notice is not to be construed as an expression of opinion on our part that the contentions raised by the petitioner(s) on the merits have substance.
