UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have briefly heard Mr. N. Hariharan, learned Senior Counsel, who is appearing on behalf of the victim's family and Ms.

Aishwarya Bhati, learned Additional Solicitor General of India, on behalf of State of Uttar Pradesh. We have also heard Mr. K. Babu, learned Senior Counsel, appearing on behalf of private hospital as well as learned counsel appearing for respondent no.3 - Khajan Singh Manvi Health Care, Ghaziabad. With their able assistance, the report submitted by SIT has been perused.

2. At the outset, learned Senior Counsel, representing St. Joseph (Mariam) Hospital, Ghaziabad states that the hospital volunteers to pay compensation of Rs. 10 lakhs to the victim's family. Similarly, learned counsel representing respondent no.3 - Khajan Singh Manvi Health Care, volunteers to pay compensation of Rs. 2 lakhs to the family of the victim-child.

3. Let the aforesaid amount be paid through demand drafts within four weeks.

4. We are further inclined to lay down some guidelines governing timely medical aid and assistance provided to victims in such like cases.

5. Post the matter on 18.09.2026.
