**01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.

**2.** Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.

**3.** The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer: -

*“It is therefore prayed that your Lordships shall be graciously pleased enough to admit the aforesaid writ petition, issue a writ in the nature of mandamus or any form of writ/writs issuing Rule NISI calling upon the Opposite Parties particularly the Opposite Party No.2, Managing Director, Odisha State Cooperative Milk Producers Federation Limited (OMFLD), as to why direction shall not be given to him to disburse the service benefits like leave salary and held up increment after his retirement so also after dropping of the departmental proceeding against the petitioner, within a time stipulated by*



*this Hon'ble Court, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances;*

*And pass any other order/orders, direction/directions, writ/writs as this Hon'ble deem fit and proper.”*

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation vide Annexure-3 to the Writ Petition, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to the Opposite Party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the Opposite Party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted representation in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
