**ORDER**  
**(Hybrid Mode)**

**09.07.2026:** Ld. Counsel for the Appellant at the outset submits that due to inadvertent error, the Corporate Debtor (CD) namely M/s Rajuri Steels & YMT Bars Private Limited has not been arrayed as Respondent and the same appears to be a proper and necessary party. It is further submitted that permission is granted to the appellant to move an appropriate impleadment/amendment application.

Mr. Dhruv Dewan, Ld. Counsel appearing for the Respondent No. 1 submits that the decision of the withdrawal of the petition filed by the Company has been taken by the Board of Directors.

In the meantime, Mr. Atul Jain appears through VC and informed us that he would be representing the CD i.e. M/s Rajuri Steels & YMT Bars Private Limited.

In view of this, we direct the appellant to file an amended memo of parties by impleading M/s Rajuri Steels & YMT Bars Private Limited. (CD) as Respondent No. 8.

Notice for Respondent No. 1 and the CD M/s Rajuri Steels & YMT Bars Private Limited has been received by their respective Counsels and they if so wish may also file their short reply or affidavit in support of their contention.

Let the amended memo of parties be filed by the appellant within three days from today.
