UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The special leave petitions are directed against (i) judgment and order dated 26th September, 2013 dismissing CWP No.21416/2013, (ii) judgment and order dated 13th December, 2023 dismissing CWP No.27923/2018 and (iii) order

dated 26th November, 2024 dismissing RA No.474/2024, all passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh.

2. Challenge to these three orders is barred by 4413, 683 and 334 days' delay, respectively.

3. We have looked into the application for condonation of delay in filing the special leave petitions. Cause shown is absolutely insufficient.

4. That apart, even the certified copies of the impugned orders are not on record. Exemption has been prayed.

5. Looking at the exemption application, we find the reason cited to be wholly unacceptable.

6. Be that as it may, the application for condonation of delay in filing the special leave petitions stand rejected.

7. The special leave petitions stand dismissed as time barred.

8. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand dismissed.
