SPECIAL BUSINESS:

1. TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE ISSUANCE OF 90,50,000 WARRANTS CONVERTIBLE INTO EQUIVALENT NUMBER OF EQUITY SHARES OF THE COMPANY ON PREFERENTIAL BASIS TO PROMOTER & PROMOTER GROUP AND NON-PROMOTER/ PUBLIC CATEGORY.

TO CONSIDER AND, IF THOUGHT FIT, TO PASS THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AS A SPECIAL RESOLUTION:

"RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Sections 23 (1)(b), 42 and, 62(1)(c) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013, read with the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules, 2014 and the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014 (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force), the provisions of Chapter V of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2018, as amended ("SEBI (ICDR) Regulations"); Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, Securities and Exchange Board of India (Substantial Acquisition of Shares and Takeovers) Regulations, 2011, SEBI (Prohibition of Insider Trading) Regulations, 2015, to the extent applicable, and provisions of the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 including any modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force, and any other rules / regulations/ guidelines if any, prescribed by the Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI"), Reserve Bank of India ("RBI"), stock exchanges and/or any other statutory /regulatory authority, and in accordance with the provisions of the Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association of the Company and subject to the approval of the stock exchange where the shares of the Company are listed and subject to the approval(s), consent(s), permission(s) and/or sanction(s), if any, of the appropriate authorities, institutions or bodies as may be required, and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed by any of them while granting any such approval(s), consent(s), permission(s) and/or sanction(s) and which may be agreed to by the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as the "Board" which term shall be deemed to include any committee which the Board may have constituted or hereinafter constitute to exercise its powers including the powers conferred by this resolution), and subject to such terms, conditions and modifications as the Board may in its discretion impose or agree to, the consent of the members of the Company be and is hereby accorded by way of special resolution to Board, to create, issue, offer and, allot in one or more tranches, at such time or times as the Board may in its absolute discretion thinks fit, on a preferential basis ("Preferential Issue") upto 90,50,000 (Ninety Lakhs Fifty Thousand) fully convertible warrants into equivalent equity share of the Company ("Warrants") to person belonging to promoter & promoter group and non-promoter/public category being the proposed allottees, at an issue price of Rs. 63.64/- (Rupees Sixty-Three and Sixty-Four Paise only) per warrant {warrant issue price} (including the warrant subscription price and the warrant exercise price), each Warrant convertible into 1 (one) fully paid-up equity share of the Company of face value of Rs. 2/- (Rupees Two only) including a premium of Rs. 61.64/- (Rupees Sixty-One and Sixty-Four Paise only) per warrant, which is price higher than the minimum price determined in accordance with the provisions of Chapter V of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations and the Companies Act, 2013, to be convertible at an option of Warrant holder(s) in one or more tranches, within 18

(Eighteen) months from its allotment date into equivalent number of fully paid-up Equity Shares of face value of Rs. 2/- (Rupee Two Only) each aggregating up to Rs. 57,59,42,000/- (Rupees Fifty-Seven Crores Fifty-Nine Lakhs and Forty-Two Thousand Only), for cash consideration, in such manner and on such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Board of Directors in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations and other applicable laws, to the proposed allottees as mentioned below :

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT in terms of provisions of Chapter V of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, the relevant date for determining the minimum issue price for the preferential issue of the Equity shares/warrant shall be Wednesday, 15th July, 2026 (**“Relevant date”**) being the date 30 Days prior to the date of the Extra-ordinary General Meeting of the Members of the Company scheduled to be held on Friday, 14th August, 2026.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT without prejudice of the generality of the above resolution the issue of warrants convertible into equivalent number of equity shares under the preferential issue shall be subject to the following terms and conditions apart from others as prescribed under applicable laws:

- Each warrant held by the proposed allottee shall entitle each of them to apply for and obtain allotment of 1 (one) equity share of the face value of Rs. 2/- (Rupees Two each). The Equity warrant may be exercised by the warrant holder, in one or more tranches, at any time on or before the expiry of 18 months from the date of allotment of warrants by issuing a written notice to the Company specifying the number of warrants proposed to be exercised along with the aggregate amount payable thereon. The Company shall accordingly, without any further approval from members, allot the corresponding number of equity shares in dematerialized form.
- The proposed allottee(s) of the Equity Warrants shall, on the date of allotment of the Equity Warrants, pay an amount equivalent to at least 25% of the issue price per Equity Warrant, as determined in accordance with the applicable provisions of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations. The amount so paid shall be kept by the Company and adjusted and appropriated against the issue price of the Equity Shares payable upon exercise of the Equity

Warrants. The balance 75% of the issue price per Equity Warrant shall be payable by the Equity Warrant holder(s) at the time of exercise of the Equity Warrants.

- (c) The allotment of Equity warrant is proposed to be completed within a maximum period of 15 days from the date of passing this resolution, provided that where the allotment is pending on account of pendency of any approval by any regulatory authority, Stock Exchange or the Central Government then, the allotment shall be completed within 15 days from the date of receipt of such approval;
- (d) The issue of equity Shares on account of exercise option by proposed allottee shall rank pari-passu with the existing Equity Shares of the Company in all respects and that the Equity Shares so allotted during the financial year shall be entitled to the dividend declared, if any, including other corporate benefits, if any, for which the book closure or the record date falls subsequent to conversion.
- (e) The pre-preferential allotment shareholding of the Warrant Holders, if any, in the Company shall also be subject to lock-in as per the provisions of the Chapter V of SEBI (ICDR) Regulations.
- (f) The equity shares proposed to be allotted pursuant to conversion of these equity warrants shall be under lock in for such period as may be prescribed under Chapter V of SEBI (ICDR) Regulations.
- (g) The equity warrants so allotted under this resolution shall not be sold, transferred, hypothecated or encumbered in any manner during the period of lock-in provided under SEBI (ICDR) Regulations except to the extent and in the manner permitted there under.
- (h) The equity warrant holder may apply for the conversion of the outstanding convertible warrant in to equity shares of the Company within eighteen months from the date of allotment of the equity warrant on the payment of the specified consideration against each warrant.
- (i) In the event of equity warrant holder do not exercise equity warrants within the equity warrant exercise period (i.e. 18 months from the date of allotment of the equity warrant), the equity warrant shall lapse and amount paid shall stand forfeited by the company.
- (j) The issue of equity warrants as well as equity shares arising from the exercise of the equity warrants shall be governed by the regulations and guidelines issued by the SEBI or any other statutory authority as the case may be or any modification thereof.
- (k) The equity warrants by itself until converted into equity share do not give to the warrant holder any voting rights in the company in respect of such equity warrants.
- (l) The Warrants allotted under this resolution shall not be tradable on stock exchange
- (m) The price determined above and number of equity shares to be allotted on exercise of the equity warrant shall be subject to appropriate adjustments as permitted under the rules, regulations and laws, as applicable from time to time.
- (n) The equity shares arising from the exercise of the equity warrant will be listed on the stock exchange subject of the receipt of necessary regulatory permission and approval as the case may be.
- (o) The respective Warrant Holders shall make payment of Warrant Subscription Price and Warrant Exercise Price from their own bank account into the designated bank account of the Company.
- (p) The Warrants shall be exercised in a manner that is in compliance with the minimum public shareholding norms prescribed for the Company under the Listing Regulations and the Securities Contract (Regulation) Rules, 1957;
- (q) Other terms and conditions, if any, as may be prescribed and applicable relating to the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, SEBI (LODR) Regulations, SEBI (PIT) Regulations, and SEBI (SAST) Regulations.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT subject to the receipt of such approvals as may be required under applicable law, consent of the Members of the Company is hereby accorded to record the name and details of the Proposed Allottee in Form PAS-5 and the Board be and is hereby authorized to make an offer to the Proposed Allottees through Letter of Offer/ Private Placement Offer Letter cum application letter in Form PAS 4 or such other form as prescribed under the Act and SEBI (ICDR) Regulations containing the terms and conditions ("Offer Document") after passing of this resolution and receiving any applicable regulatory approvals with a stipulation that the allotment of warrant would be made only upon receipt of in-principle approval from the Stock Exchange and within the timelines prescribed under the applicable laws;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to accept any modification(s) or modify the terms of issue of Warrants, subject to the provisions of the Act and SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, without being required to seek any further consent or approval of the Members of the Company.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the monies received by the Company from the proposed allottees for application of the warrants pursuant to this Preferential Issue shall be kept by the Company in a separate bank account in accordance with Section 42 of the Companies Act.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT for the purpose of giving effect to this Resolution, the Board be and is hereby authorized to do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as it may in its absolute discretion deem necessary, desirable and expedient for such purpose to give effect to the above resolution, including without limitation, issuing clarifications, resolving all questions of doubt, effecting any modifications or changes to the above mentioned Preferential offer (including modification to the terms of the issue), entering into contracts, arrangements, agreements, documents (including for appointment of agencies, intermediaries and advisors for the Issue), making applications to BSE for obtaining of in-principle approval, filing of requisite documents with the Registrar of Companies, Mumbai ("ROC"), National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL"), Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL") and/ or such other authorities as may be necessary for the purpose, and to take all such steps as may be necessary for the admission of the Warrants and Equity Shares (to be issued on exercise of the Warrants) with the depositories, viz. NSDL and CDSL and for the credit of such Warrants / Shares to the respective dematerialized securities account of the Warrant Holders and to authorize all such persons as may be necessary, in connection therewith and incidental thereto as the Board in its absolute discretion shall deem fit without being required to seek any fresh approval of the members of the Company and to settle all questions, difficulties or doubts that may arise in regard to the offer, issue and allotment of the Warrants and Equity Shares and listing thereof with the Stock Exchange as appropriate and utilization of proceeds of the Warrants or Equity Shares, take all other steps which may be incidental, consequential, relevant or ancillary in this connection and to effect any modification to the foregoing and the decision of the Board shall be final and conclusive.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to delegate all or any of the powers herein conferred upon it by this resolution to committee of directors including any director(s) / company secretary / any officer(s) /authorized signatory(ies)/executives of the Company to give effect to the aforesaid resolution including execution of any documents on behalf of the Company and to represent the Company before any Applicable Regulatory Authorities and to appoint any professional advisors, bankers, consultants, advocates and advisors to give effect to this resolution, and further to take all other steps which may be incidental, consequential, relevant or ancillary in this regard.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT all actions taken by the Board or committee(s) duly constituted for this purpose in connection with any matter(s) referred to or contemplated in the foregoing resolution be and are hereby approved, ratified and confirmed in all respects."

In view of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) General Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, General Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, General Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 5, 2020, General Circular no. 02/2021 dated January 13, 2021, General Circular no. 19/2021 dated December 08, 2021, General Circular no. 21/2021 dated December 14, 2021, Circular No. 02/2022 dated 5th May, 2022, Circular No. 10/2022 dated 28th December, 2022, General Circular no. 09/2023 dated September 25th, 2023, General Circular No. 09/2024 dated 19th September, 2024, followed by Circular No. 03/2025 dated 22nd September, 2025 (collectively “MCA Circulars”) (collectively “MCA Circulars”) and Securities and Exchange Board of India (“SEBI”) Master circular no HO/49/14/14(7)2025-CFD-POD2/I/3762/2026 dated January, 30, 2026 (collectively “SEBI Circulars”), have permitted companies to conduct EGM through Video Conferencing (VC) or other audio-visual means (OAVM), subject to compliance of various conditions mentioned therein. In compliance with the aforesaid MCA Circulars and SEBI Circulars and the applicable provisions of Companies Act, 2013 and rules made there under, and SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“SEBI Listing Regulation), the Extra-Ordinary General Meeting (EGM) of the Company is being convened and conducted through VC/OAVM Facility, which does not require physical presence of Members at a common venue. The Company has availed the facility of Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) for convening the EGM through VC/OAVM, a detailed process in which the members can attend the EGM through VC/OAVM has been enumerated in Note number 30 of this Notice.
2. The attendance of the Members attending the EGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of ascertaining the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act).
3. **ELECTRONIC DISPATCH OF NOTICE:** In compliance with the aforesaid MCA and SEBI circulars physical copies of Notice calling the EGM pursuant to Section 101 of the Act read with the Rules framed there under are being sent only in electronic mode to those Members whose e-mail addresses are registered with the Company/R&STA or the Depositories. The Company will not be dispatching physical copies of Notice of EGM to any Member.

To support the ‘Green Initiative’, Members who have not yet registered their email addresses are requested to register the same with their DPs in case the shares are held by them in electronic form and with the Company/R&STA in case the shares are held by them in physical form after complying due procedure.

4. Members who have not registered their e-mail address and those members who have become the member of the Company after **Friday 17th July, 2026** being the cut-off date for sending soft copy of the Notice of EGM may access the same from Company’s website at www.swastika.co.in, website of CDSL www.evotingindia.com and website of the Stock Exchange i.e. BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com.
5. **A MEMBER ENTITLED TO ATTEND AND VOTE AT THE MEETING IS ENTITLED TO APPOINT A PROXY/ PROXIES TO ATTEND AND VOTE INSTEAD OF HIMSELF/HERSELF SUCH A PROXY/ PROXIES NEED NOT BE A MEMBER OF THE COMPANY.**

Since the EGM of the Company will be convened through VC/ OAVM, where there will be no physical attendance of members, the requirement of appointment of proxies pursuant to the provisions of Section 105 of the Act has been dispensed with. Accordingly, attendance slip and proxy form will not be annexed to this Notice.

6. Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 112 and 113 of the Act, corporate/ Institutional member can authorize their representatives to attend the EGM through VC/OAVM and cast their votes through e-voting. Provided a scan copy (PDF) of the Board Resolution authorizing such representative to attend the EGM of the Company through VC/OAVM on its behalf and to vote through remote e-voting shall be sent to the Scrutinizer through the registered email address of the member(s) at darshika.wankhede1411@gmail.com with a copy marked to the Company at info@swastika.co.in.
7. The Statement as required under Section 102 of the Act setting out material facts concerning the business mentioned in notice is annexed hereto.

8. IEPF:

Shareholders are requested to note that, pursuant to the provisions of Section 124 of the Act read with IEPF Rules, all shares on which dividend has not been paid or claimed for seven consecutive years or more shall be transferred to IEPF Authority as notified by the MCA. In accordance with the aforesaid IEPF Rules, the Company has sent individual communication to all Members whose shares are due for transfer to the IEPF Authority and whose email IDs are available, informing them to claim their unclaimed/unpaid dividend before due date to avoid such transfer of shares to IEPF Authority and has also published notice in this regard in Newspapers.

Members whose unclaimed dividends/shares are/will be transferred to the IEPF Authority can claim the same by making an online application to the IEPF Authority in the prescribed Web Form IEPF-5 by following the refund procedure as detailed on the website of IEPF Authority <http://www.iepf.gov.in/IEPF/refund.html>.

9. The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has mandated the submission of Permanent Account Number (PAN) by every participant in securities market. Members holding shares in electronic form are, therefore, requested to submit their PAN to their Depository Participants with whom they are maintaining their demat accounts and securities holders holding securities in physical form should submit their PAN and Bank account details to the RTA.
10. Members who hold shares in dematerialized form and want to provide/change/correct the bank account details should send the same immediately to their concerned Depository Participant(s) and not to the Company. Members are also requested to give the MICR Code of their bank to their Depository Participant(s). The Company will not entertain any direct request from such Members for change of address, transposition of names, deletion of name of deceased joint holder and change in the bank account details. While making payment of Dividend, the Registrar and Share Transfer Agent is obliged to use only the data provided by the Depositories, in case of such dematerialized shares.
11. Members who are holding shares in physical form are advised to submit particulars of their PAN details, e-mail address, Mobile Number, bank account, viz. name and address of the branch of the bank, MICR code of the branch, type of account and account number etc. to our Registrar and Share Transfer Agent in prescribed Form ISR-1 quoting their folio number and enclosing the self-attested supporting document and other forms pursuant to SEBI Master Circular No. HO/38/13/(4)2026-MIRSD-POD/I/4298/2026 dated 06 February 2026.
12. Members who still hold share certificate(s) in physical form are advised to dematerialize their shareholding to avail the benefits of dematerialisation, which includes easy liquidity since trading is permitted in dematerialised form only, electronic transfer and elimination of any possibility of loss of documents. Any requests for transfer of securities are not permitted unless the securities are held in dematerialised form with a depository. Members may please note that pursuant to Regulation 40 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, transfer of securities is permitted only in dematerialised form, except under the special window open from 05 February 2026 to 04 February 2027 for transfer and demat of physical securities which were sold/purchased prior to 01 April 2019.

Further, SEBI vide Circular No. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSD_RTAMB/P/CIR/2022/8 dated January 25, 2022 and further amended vide its Circular No. HO/38/13/(3)2026-MIRSD-POD/I/3763/2026 dated 30 January 2026, has mandated listed companies to issue securities in dematerialised form only while processing investor service requests such as issue of duplicate securities certificate, claim from unclaimed suspense account, renewal/exchange of securities certificate, endorsement, subdivision/splitting, consolidation of folios/securities certificates, transmission and transposition. Accordingly, the issuance of 'Letter of Confirmation' has been discontinued as per latest amended provisions. Members are therefore requested to submit duly filled and signed Form ISR-4 for availing such services. Members may note that service requests shall be processed only after the folio is KYC compliant. Accordingly, Members holding shares in physical form are advised to dematerialise their shareholdings at the earliest.

13. SEBI vide its Master Circular No. HO/38/13/(4)2026-MIRSD-POD/I/4298/2026 dated 06 February 2026 introduced common and simplified norms for processing investor's service request by Registrar and Transfer Agent(s) (RTAs) and norms for furnishing PAN, KYC details and Nomination. *Considering 100% conversion of Warrants into equity shares within the stipulated time.

The total amount of Issue size allocated for different objects of the Issue shall together be used only for the object of the Issue as specified herein and same shall not be added to General Corporate Purpose (GCP).

Pending utilization of the proceeds of the Issue towards the Objects of the Issue, the Company shall temporarily deposit the unutilized funds in term deposits with one or more scheduled commercial banks included in the Second Schedule to the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934.

Given that the Preferential Issue includes issuance of the Warrants, the Issue Proceeds in respect of the Warrants shall be received by the Company within 18 (eighteen) months from the date of allotment of the Warrants in terms of Chapter V of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, and as estimated by the management the entire Issue Proceeds with respect to the Warrants would be utilised for all the aforementioned objects, in phases, as per the Company's business requirements and availability of Issue Proceeds, within the timelines set out above.

In terms of the BSE Circular No. 20221213-47 dated 13th December, 2022, as amended, the amount specified for the aforementioned Objects may deviate +/- 10% depending upon the future circumstances given that the Objects are based on management estimates and other commercial and technical factors. The Board of Directors in its meeting held on 20th July, 2026 has approved the issuance and allotment of not exceeding 90,50,000 warrants convertible into equivalent number of equity shares at an issue price of Rs. 63.64/- (Rupees Sixty-Three and Sixty-Four Paise only) each aggregating up to Rs. 57,59,42,000/- (Rupees Fifty-Seven Crores Fifty-Nine Lakhs and Forty-Two Thousand Only), subject to the approval of members in ensuing Extra-Ordinary General Meeting.

The Preferential Issue is being made in accordance with the applicable provisions of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, as amended, and is subject to receipt of necessary approvals from the stock exchange and any other regulatory authorities, as may be applicable.

The Proposed Allottees have also confirmed their eligibility in terms of Regulation 159 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 (the "SEBI ICDR Regulations"), to subscribe to the Warrants to be issued pursuant to the Preferential Issue.

e. Time frame (proposed time) within which the preferential issue shall be completed and material terms:

i. Undertaking that the issuer shall re-compute the price of the specified securities in terms of the provision of these regulations where it is required to do so and other undertakings:

In terms of SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, 2018 issuer hereby undertakes that:

l. Pricing of the Issue including the basis or justification for the premium and Relevant Date:

The price of the warrants convertible into equivalent number of equity shares proposed to be issued has been determined in accordance with the preferential issue guidelines given in SEBI (ICDR) Regulations and subsequent amendments thereto which is based on the relevant date i.e., 15th July, 2026, which is thirty days prior to the date of Extra Ordinary General Meeting (EGM to be held on 14th August, 2026). The equity shares are listed on the BSE Limited (BSE) and are frequently traded. Accordingly, the minimum issue price of warrants convertible into equivalent number of equity shares has been calculated with reference to trading volume at BSE as per SEBI ICDR.

In terms of the provisions of Regulation 164(1) of SEBI ICDR Regulations, the minimum price at which the Warrants can be issued is Rs. 63.63/-, as per the pricing formula prescribed under the SEBI ICDR Regulations for the Preferential Issue and is the highest of the following:

- a. the 90 trading days volume weighted average price (VWAP) of the related equity shares quoted on the recognized stock exchange preceding the relevant date i.e. Rs. 62.34/-; or
- b. the 10 trading days volume weighted average prices (VWAP) of the related equity shares quoted on a recognized stock exchange preceding the relevant date i.e. Rs. 63.63/-.

The Articles of Association of the Company do not prescribe a particular method to determine the price of the Preferential Issue which results in floor price higher than determined price pursuant to SEBI (ICDR) Regulations.

The proposed allotment is more than 5% of the post issue fully diluted share capital of the Company to an allottee or to allottees acting in concert. Hence, in terms of Regulation 166A of SEBI ICDR Regulations, the Company has obtained a valuation report from an independent registered valuer for determining the price. The price determined through Valuation report issued by Mr. Rohit Khandelwal, Chartered Accountant and Independent Registered Valuer (IBBI Regd. No. IBBI/RV/03/2020/13235) having office at SPARK HOUSE, 51, Scheme number 53, Vijay Nagar, Near Medanta Hospital, Indore (M.P.) is Rs. 63.63/- per warrant in accordance with Regulation 166A of the SEBI ICDR Regulations (“Valuation Report”).

Accordingly, the Board has considered the issue price of Rs. 63.64 per warrants convertible into equivalent number of equity shares of face value of Rs. 2/- each (inclusive of premium of Rs. 61.64/- per warrant), which price is higher of the floor price determined in accordance with applicable provisions of ICDR as detailed above.

A Certificate has obtained from the Practicing Company Secretary confirming that the minimum price for the preferential issue is as per Preferential Issue Regulations in Chapter V of SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, 2018.

None of the Proposed Allottees are categorized as Qualified Institutional Buyers.

m. Principal terms of Assets charged as securities: Not Applicable

n. The justification for the allotment proposed to be made for consideration other than cash together with valuation report of the registered valuer:

Not applicable as the Preferential Issue will be undertaken for cash consideration.

o. SEBI Takeover code:

In the present case none of the proposed allottees would attract SEBI Takeover Code and therefore is not under obligation to give open offer to the public except making certain disclosures to Stock Exchanges, if required.

p. Holding of shares in demat form, non-disposal of shares by the proposed allottees and lock-in period of shares:

The entire shareholding of the proposed allottees in the company, is held by them in dematerialized form. The proposed allottees have not sold their shares during the 90 trading days prior to the relevant date and are eligible for allotment of warrants convertible into equivalent number of equity shares on preferential basis. The proposed allottees have Permanent Account Number. The entire pre preferential allotment shareholding of such allottees shall be under lock-in as required under Regulation 167 of SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, 2018.

q. Lock-in Period:

Pre preferential holding if any and the warrants convertible into equivalent number and resultant equity shares to be allotted shall be subject to 'lock-in' for such a period as the case may be from the date of trading approval from BSE where the securities of the Company are listed as per Clause 167 of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, 2018.

r. Listing:

The Company will make an application to BSE at which the existing equity shares are presently listed, for listing of the equity shares that will be issued on conversion of warrants. Such Equity Shares, once allotted, shall rank pari passu with the then existing Equity Shares of the Company, in all respects, including voting rights and dividend.

s. The number of persons to whom allotment on preferential basis have already been made during the year, in terms of number of securities as well as price:

No securities have been allotted on a preferential basis by the Company during the current financial year 2026-27 up to the date of this Notice.

The last preferential allotment was made pursuant to the conversion of share warrants originally allotted on a preferential basis on 20th December, 2023. Out of such warrants, a portion was converted into equity shares on 12th

March 2025 and the balance warrants were converted into equity shares on 6th June 2025, falling during the previous financial year 2025-26.

t. Compliances:

The company has complied with the requirement of Rule 19A of the Securities Contracts (Regulation) Rules, 1957 and Regulation 38 of SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 maintaining a minimum of 25% of the paid up capital in the hands of the public.

u. Material terms of raising such securities

The same has been disclosed in the appended resolution herein above.

v. Other disclosures/undertaking:

1. The Company does not have any outstanding dues to SEBI, Stock Exchanges or the Depositories.
2. The Company has obtained the Permanent Account Numbers (PAN) of the proposed allottees, before an application seeking in-principle approval is made by the Company to the stock exchange(s) where its equity shares are listed;
3. The Company shall be making application seeking in-principle approval to the stock exchange, where its equity shares are listed, on the same day when this notice will be sent in respect of the general meeting seeking shareholders' approval by way of special resolution;
4. The Company is in compliance with the conditions for continuous listing;
5. Since the Equity Shares have been listed on the recognized stock exchanges for a period of more than 90 trading days prior to the Relevant Date, the Company is not required to re-compute the price in terms of SEBI ICDR Regulations;
6. None of the Proposed Allottees has sold any equity shares during 90 trading days preceding the Relevant Date;
7. The Equity Shares held by all the proposed allottees in the Company are in dematerialized form only;
8. The Company is eligible to make the Preferential Allotment under Chapter V of the SEBI ICDR Regulations.

w. Monitoring Agency:

Since the issue size is not above One hundred Crores Rupees, the Company is not mandatory to be monitored by Credit Rating Agency registered with SEBI pursuant to Regulation 162A of SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, 2018.

x. Approval under the Companies Act:

Section 62(1) of the Companies Act, 2013 provides, inter alia, that whenever it is proposed to increase the subscribed capital of a Company by further issue and allotment of shares/convertible warrants, such shares/ convertible warrants shall be approved by the shareholders by way of special resolution in general meeting.

Accordingly, the consent of the shareholders is being sought pursuant to the provisions of Section 62(1) of the Companies Act, 2013 and all other applicable provisions, SEBI Guidelines or Regulations and the provisions of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 for authorizing the Board to offer, issue and allot convertible warrants as stated in the resolution, which would result in a further issuance of securities of the Company to the promoter/promoter group and non-promoters/public category on a preferential allotment basis, in such form, manner and upon such terms and conditions as the Board may in its absolute discretion deem fit.

Further note that the provisions of Regulation 164A are not applicable to the proposed preferential allotment of warrants, as the issuance is being made to identified investors under a targeted preferential route, without affecting the general public shareholders or triggering public shareholding thresholds. Further, the warrants are contingent and convertible in nature, and their allotment is fully compliant with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, thereby rendering the procedural requirements of Regulation 164A inapplicable in the present case.
