Notice. Mr. Raman Jamalta, learned counsel, appears and waives service of notice on behalf of the respondents.

2. Under office order dated 04.04.2026, the petitioner was transferred from Palampur Unit of HRTC to Tara Devi Unit. He has also been relieved in absentia in compliance to the aforesaid office order on 27.04.2026 (Annexure P-1). Petitioner seeks his adjustment on account of medical grounds. In this regard, he has preferred a

representation on 03.05.2026 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.1/competent authority is directed to consider and decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a time bound schedule. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents is not averse to this prayer.

3. Having regard to the afore-submissions, but without examining the merits of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1/competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner dated 03.05.2026 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law and applicable transfer policy, within a period of two weeks from today. The decision so arrived at shall also be communicated to the petitioner.

The writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms, so also the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any.
