Mr. Rahul Consul, learned counsel for the petitioner is connected virtually. 2. Mr. Sandeep Tiwari, learned counsel for respondent nos. 1 & 2. 3. Mr. Aryan Dev Uniyal, learned counsel for respondent no. 3. 4. By means of this writ petition, petitioner has sought the following reliefs:- (i) Issue a Writ of Certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction calling for records and quashing the impugned arbitrary termination order dated 06.09.2026 (Annexure no. 6 Page No. 146 to 152 of Writ Petition) whereby the Franchise Agreement of Petitioner's franchise (Haridwar Elmas) has been terminated for UPL Season 3. (ii) Issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the Respondents to conduct a joint financial reconciliation after duly accounting for the depositing ₹50,00,000/-, the Season 2 winner amount of ₹25,00,000/-, and the Central Pool allocation. (iii) Issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the Respondents to permit the Petitioner to participate in UPL Season 3 and its associated player draft upon payment of legitimately reconciled net dues.

Mr. Rahul Consul, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the relief claimed do not survive, as grievance raised by petitioner in this writ petition is now redressed and petitioner has been permitted to participate in Uttarakhand Premier League. 6.
