A W A R D

- 1.** As of now, the settlement has not been entered into between the parties.
- 2.** Learned counsel appearing for the parties, in chorus, have submitted that they are agreeable for resolution of the dispute. In furtherance of the same, an amount of Rs.20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs) and Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs) has been agreed by the learned counsel for respondent No.1, United India Insurance Co. Ltd., to be paid as lumpsum compensation to petitioner No.1 and petitioner No. 2, respectively, which would be in addition to the compensation as awarded by the High Court. The said offer is accepted by the petitioners – claimants.
- 3.** Accordingly, their statements are being placed on record. The said enhanced compensation shall be deposited before the jurisdictional Tribunal within two months from today. Upon such deposit being made, the petitioners-claimants would be at liberty to withdraw the same.
- 4.** The petitioners-claimants are at liberty to furnish their bank account details to facilitate the transfer of the amount through NEFT / RTGS, if so desired.
- 5.** Learned counsel for the parties pray that an award may be passed in terms of the settlement arrived at before the Special Lok Adalat.

6. The Registry is directed to draw the award accordingly.

7. The special leave petition is disposed of in terms of the aforesated settlement.
