O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Heard Mr. Aishwary Jaiswal, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. R.K.Jain, learned Senior Counsel appearing on caveat for the respondent(s).
3. Even though we are not inclined on the merits of the

matter, we are inclined to set aside the costs of Rs.1,00,000/- imposed on the petitioner(s)-authority. Learned counsel for the petitioner-authority has undertaken that the entire compensation due with all statutory additions and interest, would be released, within a period of five weeks from today.

4. The competent officer of the petitioner-authority, shall file an undertaking to this effect within a period of one week from today in this Court.

5. We have waived the aforesaid cost, considering the fact that the petitioner-authority have fairly undertaken to release entire compensation due with all statutory additions and interest, within a period of five weeks from today. In case of any breach of the undertaking, apart from other consequences, we also make it clear that the said cost as waived now, will be revived.

6. With the above observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
