HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

The present contempt petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, alleging non-compliance of the order dated 29.01.2026 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.38430 of 2025, wherein the following directions were issued:-

“4. In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, respondent No.3-Director General, Department of Transport, Government of Haryana, Sector 17, Chandigarh, is directed to decide the legal notice dated 25.05.2025 (Annexure

P-6), after providing due opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The order so passed shall be furnished to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.”

2. Today, learned State counsel has handed over in Court a photocopy of the order dated 10.07.2026 passed by the Director, State Transport, Haryana. Same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

3. Learned State counsel, while referring to the aforesaid order dated 10.07.2026, and on instructions from Mr. Nirmal Singh, Accountant, submits that the directions contained in the order dated 29.01.2026 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.38430 of 2025 already stand complied with.

4. The said fact is also not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner and he submits that the present contempt petition may be disposed of accordingly, with liberty to the petitioner and/or its members to avail their remedies against the aforesaid order dated 10.07.2026, in accordance with law (if so advised).

5. Learned State counsel has not disputed to the aforesaid course being adopted.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
