UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Ms. Nandita Rao, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner. Learned Senior Counsel submits that Section 37 appeal of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short, 'A&C Act') itself was filed against the order of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram, Haryana (for short, 'Civil Judge, Gurugram'). The Civil Judge, Gurugram, had dismissed the Section 8 Application of A&C Act, primarily relying on the observations of the High Court of Punjab & Haryana at Chandigarh in C.R.No.5780/2025 under which the order setting

the petitioner *ex-parte* in the suit was set aside.

2. The contention of the learned Senior Counsel is that Section 8 of A&C Act is that the Civil Judge, Gurugram erred in dismissing the application by relying on the observations of the High Court" which according to learned Senior Counsel was made in the context of order 9 rule 13 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908(for short, 'CPC'). Learned Senior Counsel submits that by the impugned order, while the Section 37 appeal of A&C Act, is registered, interim stay of suit has not been granted.

3. Be that as it may, these are for the Additional District Judge, Gurugram, Haryana (for short, 'ADJ, Gurugram'), to consider while hearing the appeal.

4. We are told that the appeal is posted on 11.09.2026.

5. We also told that the respondent(s) is served in the appeal.

6. We direct that the appeal be taken up by the ADJ, Gurugram on 24.08.2026.

7. In the meantime, let the Civil Judge, Gurugram be apprised of this Court's order. The Civil Judge, Gurugram, shall postpone the suit to a date, after 24.08.2026.

8. Needless to say that appeal before the ADJ, Gurugram be decided on its own merits, uninfluenced by any of the observations in the present order.

9. With the above observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

10. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed

of.
