(2) According to petitioner, he has submitted a compliance report to Indian Nursing Council on 9.7.2026 and thereafter a request was made by the petitioner to inspect the college, however no decision has been taken on such request. (3) Learned Counsel for Indian Nursing Council, however, submits that as per the guidelines of Indian Nursing Council, inspection can be done only twice within a period of five years. (4) Learned Counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that Indian Nursing Council had issued a letter to petitioner college on 10.6.2026 to remove certain deficiencies and since petitioner has removed all the deficiencies, therefore, it is incumbent upon the Indian Nursing Council to inspect the college, to ascertain whether



			the deficiencies have actually been removed or not. (5) Without going further into the matter, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to make formal application for inspection to Indian Nursing Council. If petitioner makes such application afresh, Indian Nursing Council shall take decision thereupon, as per law, within four weeks from the date of receiving such application.
