UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. As per the office report, service qua respondent nos.3,8,9,11,13 & 15 in (C) No.15345/2026 and respondent no. 10 in SLP(C) No. 15130/2026 is complete, but no one has entered

appearance on their behalf. Service on respondent nos. 2,4,5,6,7,10,12,14,16,17 & 18 in (C) No.15345/2026 and respondent nos. 2 to 9 & 11 in SLP(C) No. 15130/2026 is incomplete.

2. Let fresh steps for service on unserved respondents be positively taken by furnishing complete and latest particulars, within two weeks.

3. In the event of steps being taken, issue fresh notice on respondent nos. 2,4,5,6,7,10,12,14,16,17 & 18 in (C) No.15345/2026 and respondent nos. 2 to 9 & 11 in SLP(C) No. 15130/2026, returnable on 03.09.2026.

4. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted.

5. In the notice itself, let it be mentioned that respondents are required to file their counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing.

6. In the interest of justice, we request and appoint Ms.Sharvari Shinde, learned counsel (email id:sharvarishinde112@gmail.com and Enrol.No. MAH/3292/2023), as *amicus curiae* (pro bono), to assist the Court on behalf of respondent no.3,8,9,11,13 & 15 in (C) No.15345/2026 and respondent no.10 in SLP(C) No. 15130/2026.

7. The Registry is directed to supply the complete paper book in digital form to the learned *amicus curiae* within a period of one week.

8. Learned *amicus curiae* shall endeavour to get in touch with the said respondents directly, in writing, apprising them about

the pendency of the present petition; passing of this order; their right of engaging a counsel of choice; and their right of being represented, subject to eligibility, through a Legal Aid Counsel.

9. Learned *amicus curiae* shall also get in touch with the Chairman of the concerned District Legal Services Authority, who shall have the above said respondents apprised of their rights to the aforesaid effect.

10. We clarify that the learned *amicus curiae* shall continue to assist the Court, even if the respondents are represented by a legally engaged counsel.

11. The Registry shall communicate this order to all concerned forthwith.

12. The Registry shall print the name of the learned *amicus curiae* in the cause list.
