O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.

2. Mr. Sanjay Jain, the learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that although the Central Excise and Customs Commissionerate Inspector (Central Excise, Preventive Officer and Examiner), Group 'B' Posts Recruitment Rules, 2016 were notified on 26-12-2016, the Government of India issued Memo. dated 23-2-2017 and 23-3-2017 respectively issuing directions to conduct DPCs to fill up the existing vacancies through the feeder grade Officer as per old Recruitment Rules, 2002 for those who are completing regular service of 2 years as Senior Tax Assistant as on

1-4-2017. Basing these Memo., the DPCs were held and the petitioners were promoted to the post of Inspector which has subsequently been cancelled and assailed in the original application before Central Administrative Tribunal and the High Court.

3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable in six weeks.

4. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted.
