UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

- 1. The appellant in First Appeal From Order No. 1011 of 2026 before the High Court is the special leave petitioner.**
- 2. The special leave petition challenges the interim order dated 24.04.2026, particularly the direction contained in paragraph Nos. '9' and '10',**

which read as under:

"9. Until further orders of this Court, the effect and operation of the award dated 30.12.2025 passed by the Motor Accident Claim Tribunal, Ghazipur in M.A.C.T. No. 55 of 2022 (Smt. Savita Devi and others Versus Uttar Pradesh State Road Transport Corporation and others) shall remain stayed, provided the appellant deposits entire amount awarded by the Tribunal along with upto date interest before the Tribunal within six weeks from today.

10. The Tribunal shall release the 50% of the amount deposited by the appellant under this order in favour of the claimants immediately on filing of an application by them, without asking for any security/surety. Share of minor claimants) (if any), shall be invested in fixed deposit scheme till he/she/they would attain majority."

3. This Court has issued limited notice for deciding whether the respondents are required to furnish security while withdrawing the 50 per cent allowed to be withdrawn by the respondents/claimants.

4. We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

5. We are of the view that the conditions in paragraph Nos. 9 to 11 are modified as under:

The petitioner is directed to deposit 25 per cent of the amount awarded together with interest within four (04) weeks from

today. The respondents are permitted to withdraw the amount deposited by the petitioner without furnishing security.

6. There shall be stay of the Award subject to complying with the above directions.

7. The special leave petition stands disposed of in the above modified terms.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
