O R D E R

1. We have gone through the contents of the Curative Petition(s) and the connected papers. In our considered opinion, no case for entertaining the Curative Petition(s) is made out within the parameters indicated by this Court in *Rupa Ashok Hurra v. Ashok Hurra & Anr.*, (2002) 4 SCC 388.

No case for review within the parameters of Order 47 Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 is set up." Ordered accordingly.

3. Save and except the aforesaid correction, no case for interference is made out. The Curative Petition(s) are, accordingly, dismissed.
