The present application has been filed under Section 66 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016, seeking, inter alia, directions against the Respondents to jointly and severally contribute a sum of Rs.1,18,00,000/- to the account of the Corporate Debtor, *Accent Packaging Private Limited (In Liquidation)*, on account of alleged fraudulent transactions/wrongful trading, invocation of Section 65(1) of the Code against Respondent No. 3, and other consequential reliefs under Sections 66 and 67 of the Code.

Let notice be issued to the Respondents by the Registry, returnable on the next date of hearing.
