Advance Agrolife Reports Highest Ever Quarterly Performance in its History

Q1 FY27 PAT at ₹ 225.5 million is up by 152%

Q1 FY27 Revenue at ₹ 3304 million is up by 96%

Jaipur, August 6, 2026: Advance Agrolife Limited (AAL), a leading agri-input company, has announced its results for the first quarter of the financial year 2026-27 ended on June 30, 2026.

Q1 FY2027 - key highlights

- AAL's Q1 FY27 revenue from operations at ₹ 3304 million increased by 96% Y-o-Y. Q-o-Q revenue went up by 167%.
- EBITDA for Q1 FY27 at ₹ 351 million increased by 105% Y-o-Y; and 162% Q-o-Q. EBITDA margin for Q1 were steady at 10.6%. Profit after Tax for Q1 FY27 at ₹ 225.5 million increased by a sharp 152% Y-o-Y and 202% Q-o-Q.
- AAL aims to commence operations at our new Unit-4 technical manufacturing facility at Gidani (Raj.) by Q3 FY27, This expansion will significantly enhance the company's technical manufacturing capabilities and support future growth.
- The Company has commenced construction of its upcoming Unit-5 manufacturing facility at Dahej II GIDC Industrial Estate, Bharuch, Gujarat, on land admeasuring 17,734.54 sq. mtrs. The facility, being established for the manufacture of technical grade pesticides, is expected to significantly enhance the Company's production capacity and support its long-term growth strategy.
