In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these financial results:

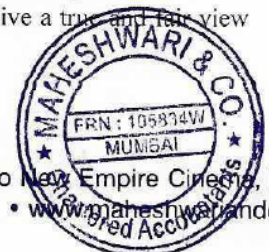
- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) in this regard; and

**Basis for Opinion**

#### **Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Results**

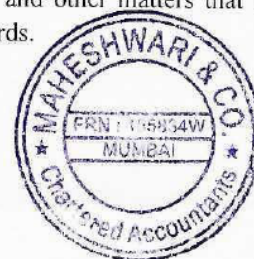

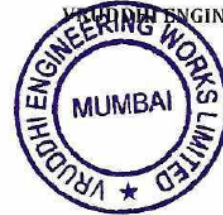

**Notes to financial results for the half year and year ended March 31, 2026**

1. The audited financial results of Vruddhi Engineering Works Limited ("the Company") for the half year and year ended March 31, 2026 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and thereafter approved and taken on record by the Board of Directors in their meeting held on May 28, 2026. The Statutory Auditor has expressed an unqualified opinion on conclusion on the financial results for the half year and year ended March 31, 2026.
2. The financial results of the company have been prepared in, accordance with accounting standards as prescribed under section 133 of the companies Act 2013 read with relevant rules thereunder and in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (LODR) Regulation, 2015.
3. The figures for the Half year ended March 31, 2026 and March 31, 2025 are represent the balancing figures derived by subtracting the reviewed year-to-date figures up to the respective half-years from the audited figures of the full financial years.
4. The Government of India has consolidated 29 existing labour legislations into a unified framework comprising four Labour Codes, viz., Code on Wages, 2019, Code on Social Security, 2020, Industrial Relations Code, 2020 and Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 (Collectively referred to as the 'New Labour Codes'). These codes have been made effective from November 21, 2025. The Company has estimated the revised gratuity liability as at March 31, 2026 as per the New Labour Codes and the additional liability arising thereon has been recognized as part of employee benefit expenses in the current reporting period. No material additional liability on compensated absences and provident fund arose on account of the aforesaid codes. The Government is in the process of notifying related rules to the New Labour Codes and impact of these will be evaluated and accounted for in accordance with applicable accounting standards in the period in which they are notified.
5. The Proceeds of fresh issue of Rs. 476 Lakhs were utilized in following manner:
