By means of this writ petition, he has sought the following reliefs:- <i>"i. Issue a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to forthwith remove the debit freeze from the petitioner's Savings Account No. 4693000100059830 maintained with Punjab National Bank, Niranjapur Sabzi Mandi Branch, Dehradun.</i> <i>ii. Direct the respondents to retain only the disputed amount of Rs.980 and permit the petitioner to operate the remaining balance.</i> <i>iii. Direct the respondents to communicate the order under which the account has been frozen."</i> 5. Mr. Ashish Joshi, learned counsel for Punjab National Bank was given time to get instructions. On instructions, he



			submits that if petitioner makes representation to the Branch Manager concerned, then petitioner's grievance shall be considered sympathetically and appropriate order shall be passed within ten days of making such representation. 6. The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of by permitting the petitioner to make representation by 07.08.2026.
