A W A R D

1. The prayer which was extended to the original petitioner having been withdrawn is the subject matter of litigation. The original petitioner having expired, his legal heirs have filed an affidavit before the Secretary of District Legal Services Authority ("for short DLSA"), Lalitpur, Uttar Pradesh, stating thereunder that they are not interested in prosecuting the present appeal. The legal heirs are present virtually and identified by the Secretary of the said DLSA. The representative of the respondent-Bank namely Shriram Kushwaha is also present virtually and reiterates the statement made by the Secretary of the

DLSA. In view of the same, we accept the statement made by the Naresh Kumar Verma(petitioner's son) and dispose of the appeal as not pressed. He has also stated his mother namely Kamlesh Devi wife of Haridas Verma was unwell and as such she could not personally attend virtual hearing. In view of the same we reserve the liberty to the other legal representatives of the deceased-petitioner to revive the appeal if they so desire to account of not having personally appeared. We dispose of this appeal, accordingly.

2. The Settlement Agreement dated 17.07.2026 also states to the said effect.

3. In view of the statement made, the civil appeal shall be treated as disposed of as withdrawn, in terms of the Settlement Agreements/Awards be drawn.
