UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Application for exemption from filing official translation is allowed.
2. Heard Mr Sanjay R.Hegde, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners.
3. Learned senior counsel submits that the original vendor/father has since passed away leaving three daughters. One daughter is married and settled. The

other two are living together in the suit property. Of the two, one of them has cognitive disabilities. Learned senior counsel submits that there is no other property for the family. It is also submitted that the petitioner No.1-Mimansa Nangia and the petitioner No.3-Shivani will file separate undertakings in this Court stating therein that the petitioner No.1 and the Petitioner No.3 together will deposit a sum of Rs.3,00,00,000/- (Rupees three crore) within a period of six weeks from today. The undertaking by the petitioner No.1 and the petitioner No.3 shall be filed within a week from today.

4. It is made clear that if there is any breach in filing the undertaking, serious consequences including the proceedings for contempt will follow. The deposit is however without prejudice to the rights of both the petitioners and the respondent.

5. On deposit of the amount by the petitioners, let notice be issued to the respondent and the amount be kept in an interest bearing FDR in any Nationalized Bank.

6. List the matter on 21st August, 2026.

7. Till the next date of hearing, *status quo*, with regard to the nature, title and possession of the suit property shall be maintained.
