1. Pursuant to MCA General Circular issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA Circulars") and SEBI Circulars time to time, physical attendance of the Members to the AGM venue is not required and Annual General Meeting (AGM) be held through video conferencing (VC) or other audio-visual means (OAVM). Hence, Members can attend and participate in the ensuing AGM through VC/OAVM.
2. In compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and MCA circulars, the AGM of the Company is being held through VC / OAVM. The Board of Directors of the Company considered that the Ordinary Business under Item No. 1 to 5 and Special Business under Item Nos. 6 to 9 be transacted at the ensuing AGM of the Company.
3. The Members can join the AGM in the VC/OAVM mode 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the AGM through VC/OAVM will be made available for 1000 members on first come first served basis. 6. CS Brajesh R. Agrawal, Practicing Company Secretary (CP No. 5649 & Membership No. F5771) BR Agrawal & Associates has been appointed as the Scrutinizer to scrutinize the e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.
7. The Scrutinizer shall within a stipulated period from the conclusion of the e-voting period unblock the votes in the presence of at least two (2) witnesses not in the employment of the Company and make a Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast in favour or against, if any, forthwith to the Chairman of the Company.
8. The Results shall be declared on or after the AGM of the Company. The Results declared along with the Scrutinizers Report shall be placed on the Company's website www.godawaripowerispat.com and on the website of NSDL within two working days from the conclusion of AGM of the Company and communicated to the Stock Exchanges (i.e. NSE & BSE).
9. The AGM is being held pursuant to the MCA circulars through VC/OVAM, physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with and the attendance of the Members through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies will not be available for the AGM and hence the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip are not annexed to this Notice. The dividend for the FY 2025-26 will be paid subject to deduction of tax at source (TDS) as applicable on the paid-up share capital of the Company of 673097430 equity shares of the nominal value of Re.1/- each. The final dividend for the FY 2025-26 will be paid within 30 days from the date of declaration to those members, whose names appear on the Register of Members of the Company and as beneficial owners in the Depositories, determined as on the Record Date (i.e. 14th August, 2026) fixed for the purpose of payment of dividend.
