1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties.
3. Pursuant to order dtd.23.06.2026, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner fairly contended that there was no extension for making the application. But since Petitioner has already made the application on 17.03.2025 under Annexure-5, his claim be considered.
4. Learned Addl. Standing Counsel contended that since the application is made beyond the time stipulated in the notice in question and the application of the Petitioner is admittedly a time barred application, it cannot be considered.
5. Having heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties and considering the submission made, since it is not disputed that Petitioner's application is time barred, this Court is not inclined to issue any direction as prayed for.



6. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of.
