3. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The Petitioners in this writ petition, pray for the following relief:

“Under such circumstances, it is therefore prayed that your lordships be graciously pleased to admit this writ application quashing the Notice dated 25.02.2026 issued by the DM, Khurda in a time barred Case vide Bank Misc. Case No.62/2019 filed by the Bank u/s 14 of the SARFAESI Act.

And may further be pleased to pass any other order(s) direction(s) as the Hon'ble Court deem fit and proper under the facts and circumstances of this case.

And for such act of kindness the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.”



3. It is submitted by Mr. Champatiray, learned counsel for the Petitioners that Bank Misc. Case No.62 of 2019, filed under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest (SARFAESI) Act, 2002, was not disposed of within the period of sixty days, as stipulated.

4. In course of hearing, Mr. Champatiray, learned counsel for the Petitioners prays for withdrawal of the writ petition and files a memo in support of his submission, which is taken on record.

5. Mr. Sahu, learned counsel appearing for the Opposite Party No.2-Indian Bank does not have any objection to such prayer.

6. In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
